REMOTE MEETING- The regular meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Willey. C.M. Dodd, C.M. Cox, C.M. Milanowski, C.M. McRoberts, C.M. Henderson, Mayor Willey, Clerk/Treasurer Oster, and Attorney Unzelman were present. Sheriff Snaza and 1 citizen were present.

A motion was made by C.M. Milanowski and seconded by C.M. McRoberts to approve the agenda. Motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by C.M. McRoberts and seconded by C.M. Henderson to approve the minutes from the previous meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by C.M. Milanowski and seconded by C.M. Dodd to approve Blanket Voucher #202104 for Claim #'s 19816 and 19818-19829 in the amount of \$22,329.24 and Payroll #'s 19817 in the amount of \$1,000.00 for a Grand Total of \$23,329.24. Motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by C.M. Henderson and seconded by C.M. Milanowski to add an additional \$5000.00 funds for the water system plan amendment. Motion passed with 4 yays, Cox abstained.

A motion was made by C.M. Dodd and seconded by C.M. Henderson to approve Ordinance #567 amending the Zoning Ordinance minimum lot size to 5000 sq. ft. Motion passed unanimously.
